With reference to the above, I am directed to state
that in exercise of the powers conferred under section
53 of Sub-Section 5 of the Karnataka State Universities
Act, 1976, subject to approval of the Dental Council of
India and without seeking any assistance from the
State Government, sanction is accorded for the year 1991-
92 for starting of Dental College by Al-Ameen Charitable
Fund Trust, Bijapur with an intake of 40 seats for

- e) They must get recognition from the Dental Council of India as early as possible.

I am directed to refer to your letter No.ADC/GNL/CR:509/2003-04/372, dated 20.10.2003, indicating that the terms & conditions contained in the Letter Of Intent, *vide* this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 19.8.2003, have been noted and furnishing the Performance Bank Guarantee No.159/03, dated 17.10.2003, issued by The Jammu & Kashmir Bank Ltd., Bangalore, Karnataka, for Rs.60 lakhs, and to convey the formal Permission of the Central Government under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to Al-Ameen Dental College, Bijapur, Karnataka, for starting MDS Course in the Specialty of Orthodontics with an annual admission capacity of 2 students from prospective effect.

2. This permission is valid for only one year and for admitting only one batch of students. Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.ADC/GNL/CR-27/1/2002-2003, dated 27.9.2002 (received on 3.10.2002), accepting the conditions contained in the Letter Of Intent issued by this Ministry on 13.9.2002 and to convey the formal Permission of the Central Government under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to the Principal, Al-Ameen Dental College, Bijapur, to start MDS Course in the speciality of Oral Surgery with 2 seats at their Al-Ameen Dental College, Bijapur from the academic Session 2002-2003.

2. This Permission is granted for a period of one year, i.e., for admitting only one batch of students during the academic session 2002-2003 and will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets.

3. The admission for 2nd batch will be made only after renewal of Permission by the Central Government. Admissions made in violation of this condition will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.

4. Further, the PBG submitted by you is valid only upto 25.9.2003. Now as per policy decision taken by the Central Government, it has been decided that the validity period of the PBG should be at least for 3 years for MDS courses. Therefore, you are requested to get the validity period of PBG extended upto 3 years and submit the same to the Government by 30th November, 2002 positively. In case of failure, the process for withdrawal of LOP would be initiated.
